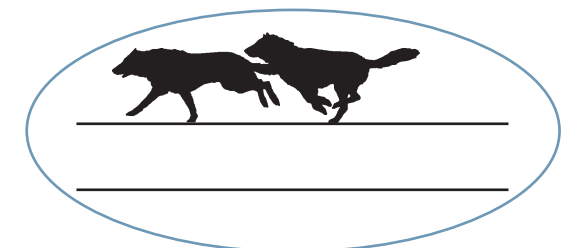

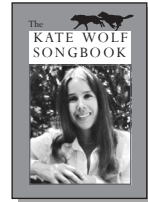

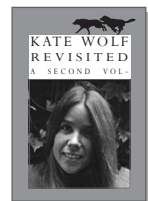


First published in May 1988, this songbook contains words and music to all of Kate's songs recorded on her first seven albums. Also featured are 75 photos from Kate's life, a wonderful piece about Kate written by her longtime friend and co-musician Bruce "Utah" Phillips, a lengthy biography and a complete discography. For several years, Kate talked about compiling a songbook, but she never found the time between her work on the road and in the studio. After her passing, her family and close musical friends designed this book with her thoughts in mind.

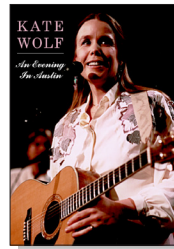


This companion volume to the first **Kate Wolf Songbook** features Kate's songs from the subsequently released albums *The Wind Blows Wild*, *Looking Back At You*, *Carry It On*, and *Weaver Of Visions*. Since the first songbook embodied Kate's works, we made it a point to "revisit" some of her favorite songs that she recorded that were written by others. These include *Telluride* and the concert favorite *The Ballad Of Weaverville*. In addition to the foreword by Tom Paxton, the book includes a lengthy introduction

discussing many of the lesser known songs. We also wanted to present how Kate felt about her songs, so we culled excerpts from hundreds of concert and radio tapes, resulting in insightful quotes in Kate's own words. Like the first songbook, there are many photos, but this time we've also included several concert posters. These feature photos of Kate and many musicians with whom she headlined. There's even a flyer showing Kate performing at her first regular venue, in 1965! In addition, the book has a complete-to-date discography. The book includes 28 songs (below) from Kate's albums, as well as 67 others (list available at www.katewolf.com/songbook).

An Evening In Austin

Kate appeared on Austin City Limits in 1985 at the height of her career, just months before she was diagnosed with acute leukemia. It was her first major television exposure and a great success. Accompanied by long-time band members Nina Gerber and Ford James, and special guest Randy Sabien, Kate delivered a strong performance that remained faithful to her well-known California folk style. Kate's family and KLRU TV restored the show to its original 75 minutes, and Nina Gerber and Tom Diamant contributed their years of experience with Kate's music in remixing the 16-track audio master for excellent balance and sound quality. Here In California

Coming in the middle of her career in 1980, this performance shows Kate firmly established as a popular singer/songwriter, but before her audience expanded from local to national. A constant presence on radio with her own folk shows, she also launched new folk festivals and other music events. With the advent of community access to cable broadcasting in the Eighties, Kate set her sights on video.

Here In California features seven songs from those initial three albums. All were written by Kate except *The Redtail Hawk*, with which she closed virtually all of her performances. Kate is accompanied by Nina Gerber on lead guitar, mandolin, and harmonica, and Rick Byars on bass and harmony vocals. This video is also a rare chance to see Kate playing piano (as well as guitar), often logistically difficult in concerts. While *Here In California* doesn't have the glossy PBS production values of *An Evening In Austin*, we think you'll enjoy watching Kate perform at an important crossroads in her career. 29 min • Color • Mono

Musical Interview

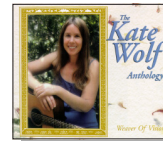

With the help of Kate's fans and friends, Kate's family compiled a definitive collection of her work that spans her entire career, including live and posthumous releases. *Weaver Of Visions*, a 2½ hour double album, also includes three songs that have not appeared on previous Kate Wolf albums: *Although I've Gone Away*, *The Minstrel*, and *Shadow Of A Life*. The 44-page booklet traces Kate's life in pictures and a 10,000 word essay by Larry Kelp, S.F. Bay Area music critic and long-time supporter of Kate's music.

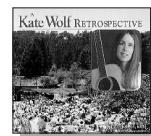


Treasures Left Behind: Remembering Kate Wolf

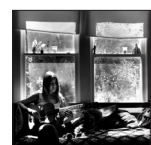

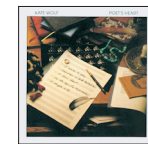
